Good news to potential Bumiputera Sarawak students who are pursuing their tertiary studies this year. Recently University College of Technology Sarawak (UCTS) and Yayasan Sarawak (YS) has collaborated in helping Bumiputera Sarawak students whose family household income are categorized under B40 and M40 to pursue their studies at private university with affordable tuition fee. However this opportunity only opens for first new 100 Bumiputera Sarawak students registered with UCTS in year 2020.

The **BP40** scheme which is available for Bumiputera Sarawak students from family background of B40 and M40 enables students to study at state owned university with tuition fees comparable to public university. Students registered for Foundation Studies programme, the actual tuition fee is RM10,000 for 1 year programme, however under the BP40 scheme, students only need to pay RM3,200 for whole 1 year tuition fee. For undergraduate programmes, tuition fee under BP40 scheme start from RM15,568 for a 3 years Business degrees, RM16,902 for a 3.5 years Computing degrees, RM17,296 for a 3.5 years Built Environment degrees and RM22,754 for a 4 years Engineering Degrees.

In addition, BP40 scheme receivers are also eligible to apply loan from Yayasan Sarawak to accommodate their tuition fees and cost of living. Eligible students will receive up to RM4,000 worth of loan per year to cover their cost of living while studying in UCTS. Upon graduation, students under Yayasan Sarawak loan only need to payback 25% of the total loan if they achieved Cumulative Grade Points Average (CGPA) of 3.50 & above and payback of 50% of the total loan if they achieved minimum CGPA of 3.00.

UCTS is a Sarawak state owned university which provide students with a state-of-the-art facilities and conducive learning environment. A university awarded with Green Building Index – Platinum Level with BP40 scheme enable Bumiputera Sarawak students pursue their dream career at an affordable fee. This BP40 scheme aims to increase the standard of Sarawak Bumiputera young people to be more competitive and competent in future.

UCTS established in 2013, is an effort by Sarawak state government to produce graduates to meet the human capital needs for Sarawak Corridor of Renewable Energy (SCORE) projects. UCTS' mission is to provide world-class educational programmes and learning environment to nurture creative and entrepreneurial leaders through a broad yet specialized education in science and technology.
